Sub: Importance of Maintaining Minimum Attendance and Minimum Internal Marks to appear in Semester End Examinations (Autonomous II Semester – 2024 batch – UG programs)

All **Second Semester Autonomous Engineering students** are hereby informed about the critical importance of maintaining the **minimum academic requirements** for eligibility to appear in Semester-End Examinations.

As per **VTU guidelines**, students must meet the following conditions:

1. Minimum Attendance Requirement:

- Students must maintain a **minimum of 85% attendance** in each course, both theory and laboratory.
- Failing to meet this requirement will result in **NSAR (Not Satisfied in Attendance Requirements)** status, which **disqualifies the student from writing the Semester End Examination of the Course/s with less than 85% attendance.**

2. Minimum Internal Marks Requirement:

- Students must secure a **minimum of 40% in each component of Internal Assessment (IA) marks.**
- Failing to achieve this will lead to **NSSR (Not Satisfied in Sessional Requirements)** status, which also **prevents the student from appearing in the Semester End Examinations for the Course/s concerned.**

Our Institution considers this as **a matter of serious importance and strictly adheres** to the guidelines prescribed by the University. Students are advised to take these requirements **seriously**, as failure to comply will **delay academic progress, cause loss of a semester and affect placement and academic standing.**

All mentors and class advisors are requested to **counsel students regularly and monitor attendance and performance.** Students must take personal responsibility to ensure timely submission of assignments, active participation in class/lab activities, and consistent preparation for internal tests.
