RNSGI – Online Mock Test: Terms & Conditions

- **RNSIT** is conducting a **Free Mock Test for KCET / PGCET aspirants** to help students prepare effectively.
- Only **registered candidates** may attempt the test using a **laptop/desktop with stable internet**.
- **180 minutes | 180 MCQs**. Attempt individually; **no mobiles, books, notes, calculators, or outside help**.
- The test is **proctored** (webcam/mic/screen/activity monitoring). Any malpractice may lead to **disqualification**.
- Do not refresh, close, or switch tabs. RNSIT is **not responsible** for internet, power, or device issues.
- Scores are **system-generated**; no re-evaluation. Participation does not **guarantee scholarships**. Only top **25 performers** are eligible to get **scholarships**.

Scholarship (Management Quota Only)

- **10%**: MBA, MCA, EEE, ME, Civil
- **5%**: CSE, AIML, Data Science, Cyber Security, ECE
- Limited to **25 seats of management quota**, whichever is lower.

By registering and attempting the test, candidates **agree to all terms**.



RNSGI Scholarship Rules & Continuation Policy

1. Eligibility for Scholarship

- Scholarship is awarded based on **performance in RNSGI Mock Entrance Tests** conducted in collaboration with partner institutions.
- Only students **admitted under Management Quota** are eligible.
- Applicable branches:
 - **10% Scholarship:** MBA, MCA, EEE, ME, Civil.
 - **5% Scholarship:** CSE, AIML, DS, Cyber Security, ECE.
- The scholarship is awarded **for the first year of admission** and may be **renewed annually** subject to performance and compliance.

2. Scholarship Renewal (Year-on-Year)

Students can continue to receive the same scholarship each subsequent year if they meet the following criteria:

1. Academic Performance:

- Must secure a **minimum of 75% aggregate marks** or equivalent SGPA in each semester.
- No arrears/backlogs during the semester / academic year.

2. Attendance Requirement:

- Maintain a **minimum of 85% attendance** per semester in all subjects and placement training if any.

3. Discipline & Conduct:

- No disciplinary action or misconduct reports during the course of study.



4. Institutional Contribution:

- Active participation in **academic, technical, or outreach events** conducted by partner Institution.
- Should serve as a **student ambassador** for the RNSGI Scholarship Program when required.

3. Loss of Scholarship Privilege

The scholarship will **not continue** if:

- The student fails to meet any of the above criteria.
- There is a **disciplinary violation**, academic malpractice, or attendance shortage.
- The student **withdraws or transfers** from RNSGI mid-course.
